The Coat of Arms This is the Arms of Robert Reeves. Major in Cronwell's army. He was the son of a respectable Susser family. I am not positive that Robert was our direct ansector. but the Coat is purely Reeves.

Origin of the Name

As early as the tenth century the occuparion gave the surname to families. In 1465, Edward IV, of England secured the enactment of a statute to the effect that either the town, the profession or the occupation could be chosen as a surname.

In very early times the King required big, strong men to guard the castle, the vivers and other strategic points. These men were called reve, hence the name. It is a Saxon word meaning officer or governor. A shirereve is now Sheriff. The name is written Reve. Reave or Reeves. In general the Reeves men have run to form in that they are big men even in the present generation.
