The Coat of Arms

This is the Arms of Robert Reeves, a Major in Cromwell's army. He was the son of a respectable Sussex family. I am not positive that Robert was our direct ancestor, but the Coat is purely Reeves.

Origin of the Name

As early as the tenth century the occupation gave the surname to families. In 1465, Edward IV. of England secured the enactment of a statute to the effect that either the town, the profession or the occupation could be chosen as a surname.

In very early times the King required big, strong men to guard the castle, the rivers and other strategic points. These men were called reeve, hence the name. It is a Saxon word meaning officer or governor. A shirereve is now Sheriff. The name is written Reve, Reeve, Reave or Reeves.

First Generation

WALTER REEVES, who was probably the emigrant ancestor of this family, settled in Burlington County, Jersey, before 1678. It has not been definitely determined whether he came direct from England to West Jersey or from the West Indies. However that may be, the family is English, and he was living in Jersey in 1678. The records would indicate that he owned a large plantation there, which was called Reeves Land.

The wills of Walter and his second wife Ann are both on record in the office of the Secretary of State, Trenton. Walter's will is dated May 1693, while Ann's is under date of 1732.

Walter was born about 1653/3, not definitely known. He died 1696. His first *wife* was probably named Susannah, and by her he had two children;
